Many of you will remember that Ardel Meisinger was able to buy a lot of socks last year to be donated to those in need.

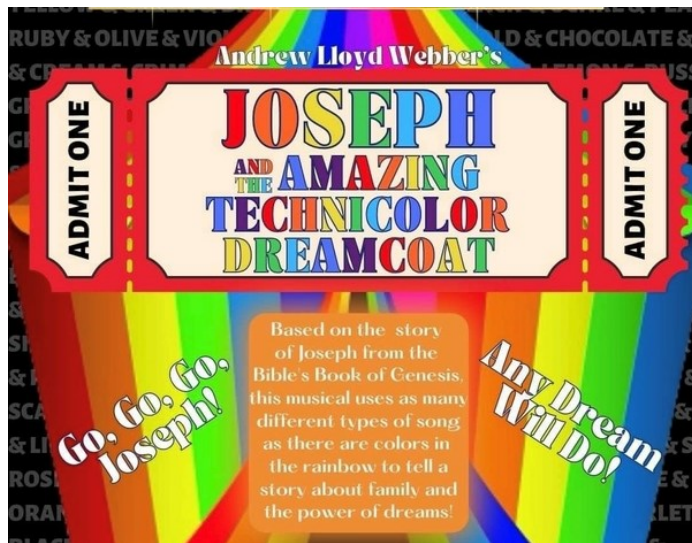
The sock sale will be held this year on August 12th. The price is \$1 per pair.
