THE DWELLING - New T-shirts, new underwear, new socks, mouth care products, shower supplies

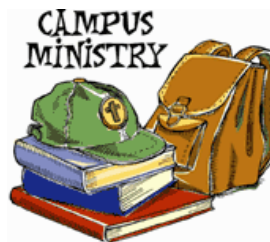
IBRAHAM FOOD PANTRY - Diapers/pullups sizes 2-6
